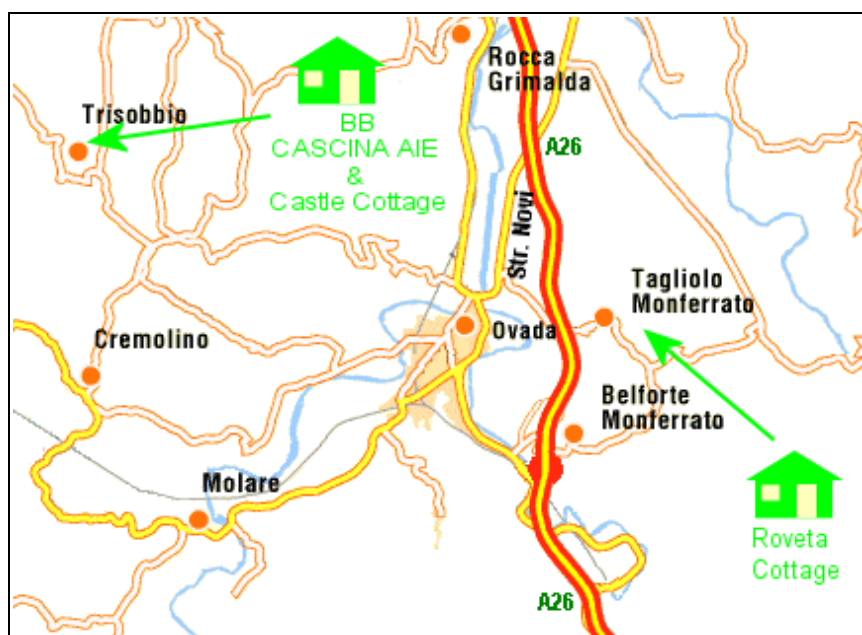


Cascina Aie - Sat Nav Help Sheet

For *both* of the cottages and for the bed & breakfast, ***your first destination will be the farmhouse*** (the Cascina) at **Trisobbio**, to collect the keys. Note there are two villages, and both with similar names.



All SatNav systems are still needing improvement for this area. Garmin / Navteq units are tending to give better results, at present. TeleAtlas / Tomtom and Google systems are still suffering from a few quirks.

Avoid searching with postcodes.

A common cross-link problem is searching 'Via San Rocco 15070 Trisobbio' which will route you to the town of Prasco, is 12 km away. In Italy postcodes can cover several square kilometres. The cottages and the farmhouse all share the same postcode.

Search - first by 'City' eg 'Trisobbio' - **then by 'Street'** key words eg 'San Rocco'.

The Farmhouse, at Via San Rocco 1 is often labelled by TeleAtlas maps as on 'Strada Comunale' San Rocco. (gps 44.663002, 8.587307)

Roveta Cottage, at Tagliolo (Monferrato), Loc. Roveta, is often listed as Strada Comunale Massoli-Cherli, 23 (gps 44.637767, 8.677475)

Castle Cottage, Via Italia 3 – First by City: Trisobbio, followed by Street: (via) Italia (gps 44.661485, 8.586477)

Remember, ***your first destination will be the farmhouse*** -

Coming from Ovada, it is a good idea to add a 'waypoint' of 'SP200 Strada Capellette' to make sure that you are routed on the SP200, otherwise the suggested route could be rather narrow.

Avoid any routes with roads that have 'vicinale' in the name, as a general rule.

On exiting the motorway A26, if you were not sure how to add waypoints, **follow the blue signs for Alessandria**. (SP185) - These will take you into Ovada and then over a river. (the left hand bridge)

Immediately after the bridge, you will see the (SP200) signposts for Trisobbio and Cascina Aie, on the left. Stay on this road for 8km. Your SatNav will re-route quite quickly and in around ten minutes you will be at the village. You will see further signs for the Cascina, if you need them.
